REASON WHY THIS DECISION DID NOT APPEAR ON THE FORWARD PLAN AND THE URGENCY PROVISIONS WERE NOT FOLLOWED:

This key decision outside the Council's Budget and Policy Framework was taken as part of the Council's emergency response to the national Coronavirus Emergency. Due to the necessary speed of decision taking at this time it was not possible to comply with the Council's Constitution that includes the requirement to give 28 days' notice of the decision to be taken; publish details 5 clear days before the decision was taken; publish the decision within 2 days of it being taken; and provide the 5 day call-in period before implementation. Nor was it possible to comply with the Urgency provisions in the Constitution

DECISION TAKEN:

The Housing and Investment service will temporally suspend non-urgent / non-essential visits in order to help to mitigate the spread of Coronavirus. Emergency / essential visits will continue.

This decision is expected to be in place until at least mid-February in accordance with the current lockdown, but may extend beyond this subject to infection rates, any additional government guidance and staff resources.

REASONS FOR DECISION:

This decision has been taken in order to mitigate the spread of Coronavirus.

FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS:

The financial implications are deemed to be minimal at present, but will be monitored and kept under review.

LEGAL IMPLICATIONS:

There are no legal implications.
