Completed nomination papers must be hand delivered to the Deputy Returning Officer, at Stevenage Borough Council, Room 157, Daneshill House, Danestrete, Stevenage, SG1 1HN from the date of this notice, on Monday to Friday between the hours of 10.00am and 4.00pm (excluding bank holidays), but no later than 4.00pm on Thursday, 1 August 2024.
4. If an election is contested the poll will take place on Thursday, 29 August 2024 between the hours of 7.00am and 10.00pm.
5. Applications to register to vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 12 midnight on Monday, 12 August 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/register-to-vote>.
6. New applications to vote by post or requests to cancel or change an existing postal or proxy vote must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Stevenage Borough Council, Daneshill House, Danestrete, Stevenage, SG1 1HN by 5.00pm on Tuesday, 13 August 2024, if they are to be effective for this election. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-postal-vote>.
7. New applications to vote by proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Stevenage Borough Council, Daneshill House, Danestrete, Stevenage, SG1 1HN by 5.00pm on Tuesday, 20 August 2024, if they are to be effective for this election. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-proxy-vote>.
8. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5.00pm on Tuesday, 20 August 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://voter-authority-certificate.service.gov.uk>.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Stevenage Borough Council, Daneshill House, Danestrete, Stevenage, SG1 1HN by 5.00pm on Thursday, 29 August 2024, if they are to be effective for this election.
