It's a jungle out there, so swing by and go bananas with our ape-a-zing monkey themed crafts.

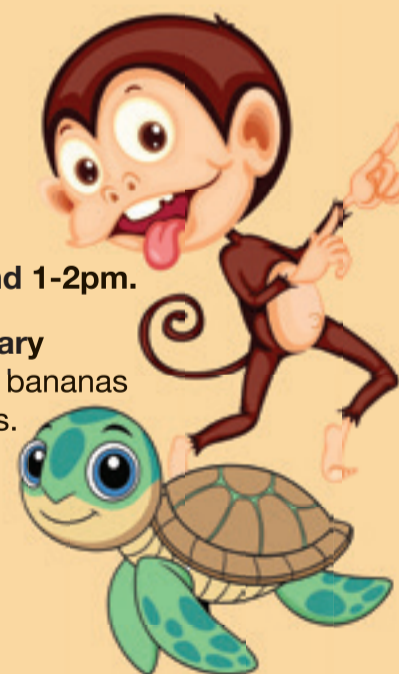
Totally Turtle, Thursday 20 February

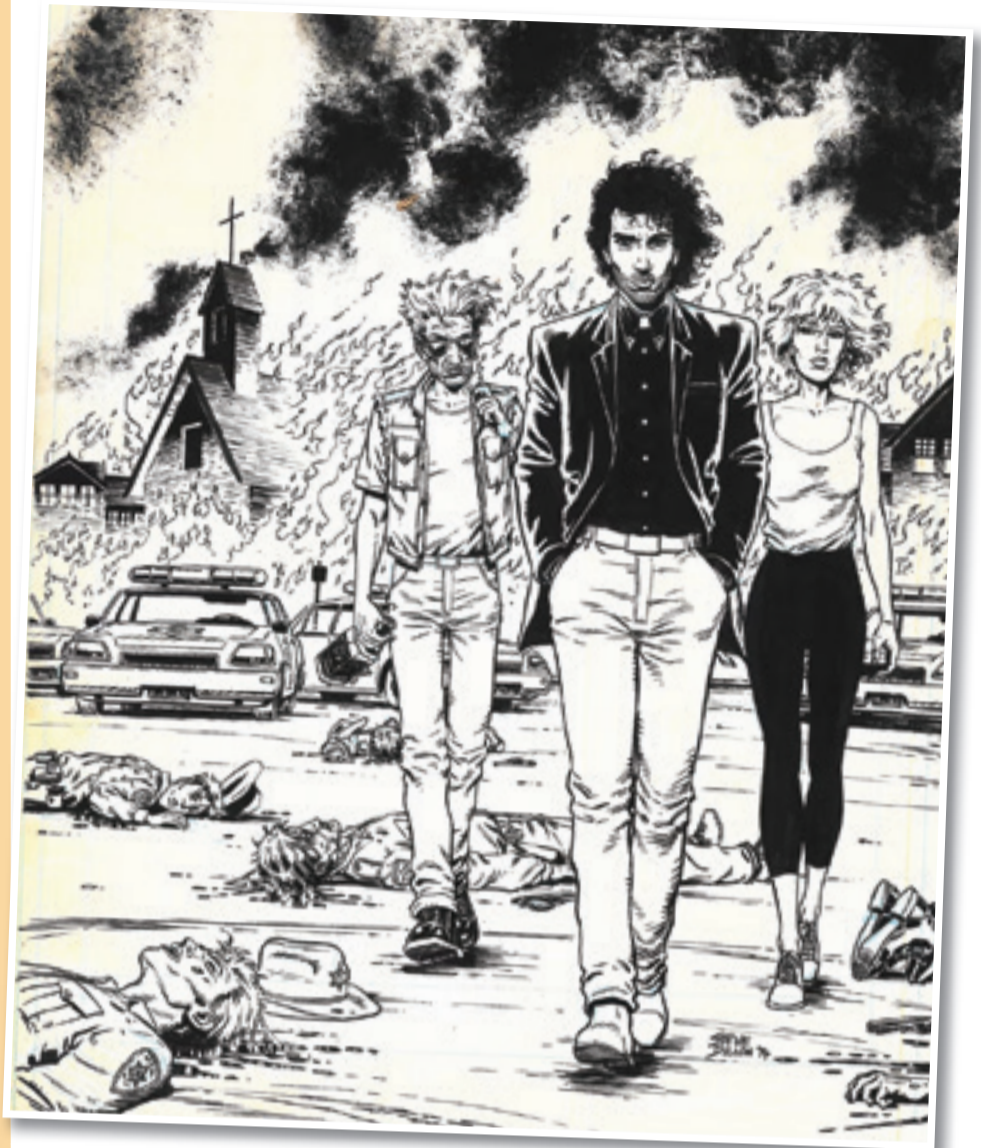

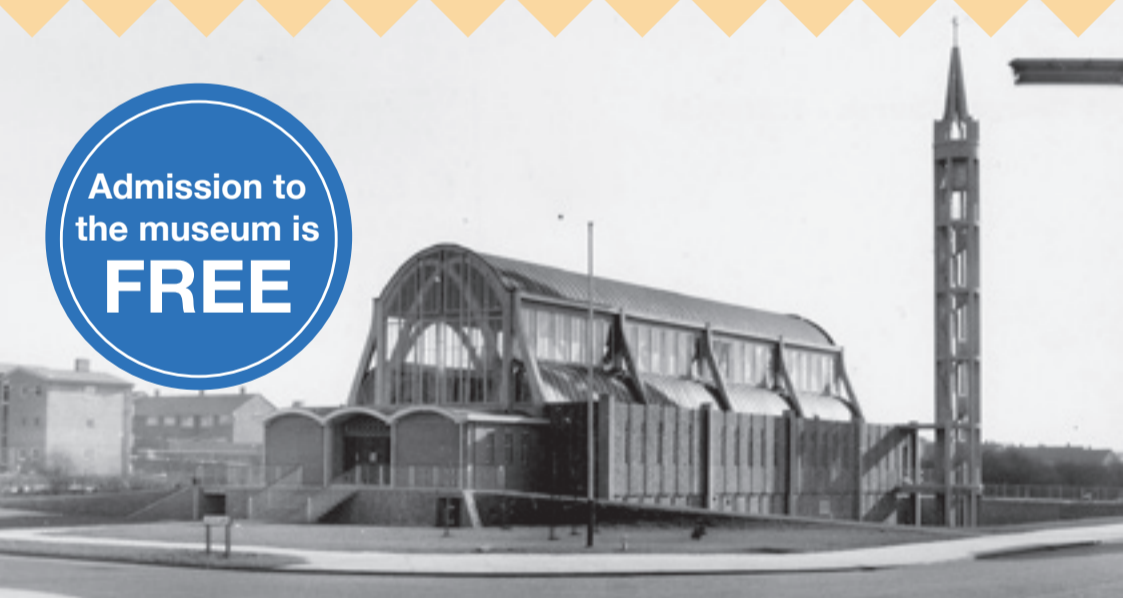
## Preacher, Punisher and Dredd

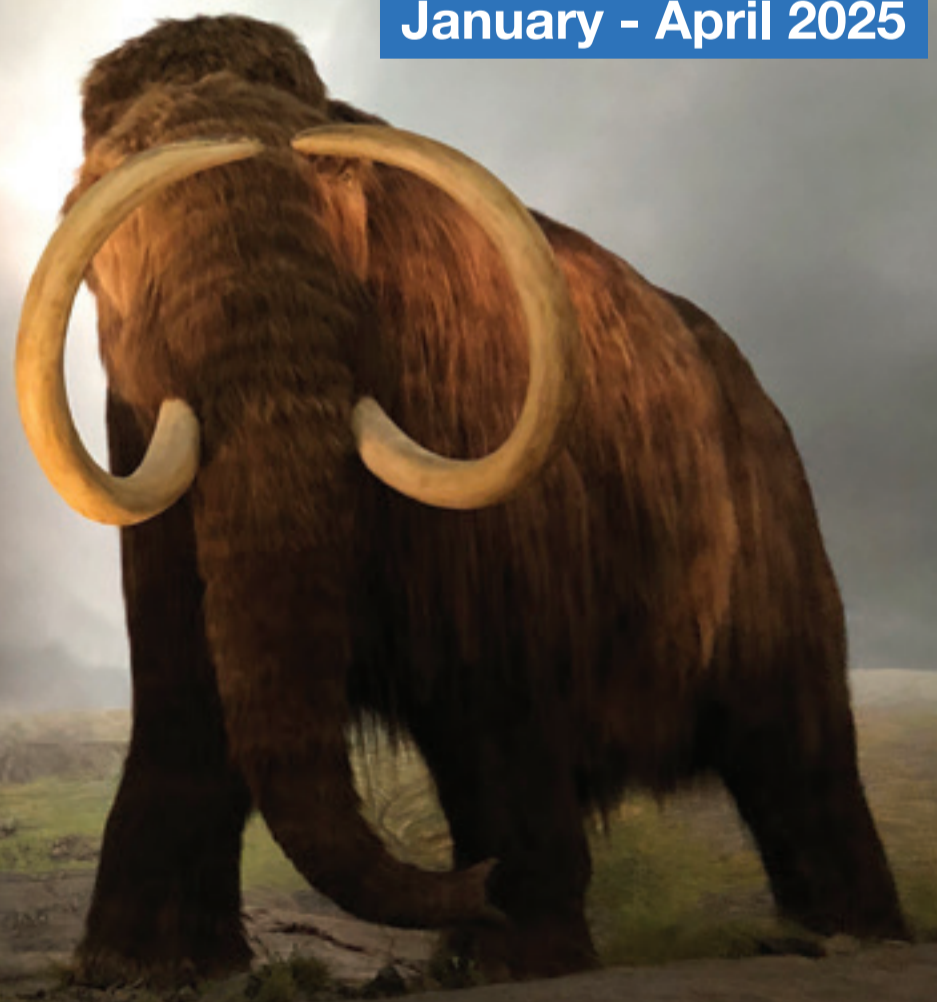
